

**TOWN OF GOLDSBORO
RESOLUTION 18-06**

A RESOLUTION supporting the Enterprise Zone Application being filed with the Maryland Department of Commerce, jointly by the Town of Ridgely, Town of Greensboro, Town of Goldsboro, and Caroline County Commissioners.

WHEREAS, The Sections 5-701 et seq. of the Economic Development Article of Annotated Code of Maryland provides for the designation of an Enterprise Zone in a political subdivision of the State; and

WHEREAS, the purpose of an Enterprise Zone is to focus local and State resources on economically distressed areas of the State; and

WHEREAS, the Town of Ridgely, Town of Greensboro, Town of Goldsboro, and Caroline County Commissioners are currently making a joint application to the Maryland Department of Commerce to establish an Enterprise Zone for the North County region and certain properties within Caroline County; and


WHEREAS, the County Commissioners support the establishment of an Enterprise Zone and the application; and

WHEREAS, the regulations governing the application for the designation of an Enterprise Zone require a resolution of support from the political subdivisions involved.




