A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF GOLDSBORO ADOPTION THE 2019 CAROLINE COUNTY HAZARD MITIGATION PLAN AS “THE GOLDSBORO 2024 HAZARD MITIGATION PLAN”

WHEREAS, THE TOWN OF GOLDSBORO, a municipality of Caroline County recognizes the Federal Disaster Act of 2000 requiring that all states and local jurisdictions develop, submit, and update hazard mitigation plans that may reduce the impacts of hazards; and


WHEREAS, an adopted hazard mitigation plan is required as a condition of future federal funding for hazard mitigation projects; and


WHEREAS the Town of Goldsboro participated in the planning process along with other units of local government within the County to prepare the 2024 CAROLINE COUNTY HAZARD MITIGATION PLAN;


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Town of Goldsboro, hereby adopts the 2024 CAROLINE COUNTY HAZARD MITIGATION PLAN as our official plan; and


BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, the Caroline County Department of Emergency Services is authorized to submit on behalf of the participating municipalities the adopted 2024 CAROLINE COUNTY HAZARD MITIGATION PLAN to the Federal Emergency Management Agency for final review and approval.
